### **Girl Scouts Donations**

Hello and Happy New Year!! We are SPMS Girl Scout Troop 10300 and we are looking for donations to support two amazing local non profit organizations. MAS Rescue and Rude Ranch.

MAS Rescue is a small, all volunteer group that is dedicated to helping unwanted shelter animals whose time has run out. MAS animals are cared for in volunteer foster homes and since 2005, MAS has rescued and placed over 5000 dogs and cats in loving forever homes. All animals receive veterinary care, and animals 22 weeks and older are spayed/neutered. The heartache of seeing animals in deplorable conditions is completely outweighed by the joy of seeing the same animals healthy and vibrant and adopted into the loving families they always deserved.

Rude Ranch Animal Rescue Center is dedicated to providing care and respite to abused, abandoned and special needs animals in our area. They also run the Spay and Neuter Nook that helps animals by providing high quality, low-cost spay/neuter and necessary veterinary services to help. Nationwide only about 30% of dogs and less than 20% of the cats turned into animal shelters are adopted or turned over to other rescues. As a result over 4.5 million animals are euthanized every year because they do not have a home. Most of these animals are young, healthy puppies and kittens that were the result of

unintended and unwanted litters of household pets. To prevent this needless waste of life, Rude Ranch supports an aggressive approach to spay/neuter, advocating the surgery for all household pets, barn cats, and strays in general. By preventing unwanted animals from being born, we will also reduce the strain on already tight agency and local budgets that must cover the cost of caring for and ultimately disposing of unwanted and homeless animals.

There will be a bin outside of 225 McKinsey Road for collections beginning this **Friday**, **January 4th through Friday**, **January 25th**. I have listed below items that would be very helpful for both organizations.
